

Nippon Columbia's Vintage Collection

The following ten CDs from Nippon Columbia's own recordings made in the 1960s and 1970s were released in July 2008 by Columbia Music Entertainment under the title of Columbia Vintage Collection.

COCQ84487 Paillard Chamber Orchestra plays Mozart: Serenade K525, etc. recorded live at Tokyo Bunkakaikan on 28 October 1968.

COCQ84488 Béla Siki plays Beethoven: Piano Sonatas, Nos. 14, 6 & 21, recorded 11 October 1962.

COCQ84489 Maria João Pires plays Mozart: Piano Sonatas, K310 & K457, Fantasia, K475, recorded May 1973 (the first analogue recording, not from Pires's later Denon Mozart recordings).

COCQ84490 Mozart; Flute Concertos. Jean-Pierre Rampal with Willy Steiner conducting the Yomiuri Nippon Symphony Orchestra, recorded April 1964.

COCQ84491 Japanese Melodies. Jean-Pierre Rampal, flute and Lily Laskine harp, recorded June 1969.

COCQ84492 Mussorgsky-Ravel: *Pictures at an Exhibition*, Haydn: Symphony No. 101, Tchaikovsky *Marche slave*. Kazuo Yamada conducting the Japan Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra, recorded June-July 1968.

COCQ84493 Ysaÿe: 6 Solo Violin Sonatas. Kazuyoshi Wanami. recorded February, July & August 1971.

COCQ84494 Tchaikovsky: Violin Concerto & Bartok: Violin Concerto No. 2. Masuko Ushioda, with Tadashi Mori conducting the Japan Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra, recorded March 1968.

COCQ84495 Popular Cello Pieces. Ken'ichiro Tokunaga, cello and Ikuyo Kamiya, piano, recorded February 1971.

COCQ84496 Operatic Arias. Atsuko Azuma, soprano. Recorded January 1969.
